Founded the very first pediatric hospital in the Philippines and 1st woman pediatrician to be admitted to Harvard Medical School in 1936.

Diosdado "Dado" Banatao

Designed and invented the first single chip 16-bit microprocessor based calculator.



Carvey Ehren Maigue

Studied electrical engineering and created a window and wall technology that utilizes a substrate. which converts ultraviolet (UV) light to solar energy.



Dr. Ramon Barba

His research led to fruiting several times a year without harming the plants and chose not to file a patent so that farmers were free to use his research at no cost.

Her work in clinical epidemiology is now the benchmark for teaching infection control to all public hospitals in the country.



Being a first-generation college student, it felt like the decisions I made were high stakes and impactful not just to me, but to my entire family.

With much reflection and research, I chose to major in Public Health Policy which tied the scientific side of health with the equally important social and communal aspects.

I can say that a big part of my world view today is through a public health lens, in which looking at and listening to an entire community of people is important as well as having a preventative approach to problems and concerns.

Two things that have helped me is learning how to ask for help and embracing the practice of re-routing plans. The road may take you in different directions and that's okay- life's not meant to be linear!

My journey at SMC started after graduating from Loyola Marymount University's Masters in Guidance Counseling graduate program in 2017, and I have enjoyed working with such creative, dynamic, and determined students in STEM.
