IV. Chairs' Business

a. Update re: SMC Interpretation for Modalities

J. Adams shared her desire to form an ad-hoc committee to redefine and examine the variety of instructional modalities currently offered. J. The Senate will vote on the creation of the committee and will follow the shared governance process.



b. Other Senate/DE Updates

The Senate is currently discussing goals, including actions to meet the 75/25 target for full-time to part-time faculty.

The DE Title 5 preliminary revisions draft was updated to include more language surrounding accessibility and changes to section 508 and ADA. The second read will happen in November Board of Governors.
