1. The committee discussed possible compromises to address concerns regarding Proctorio usage. It was suggested to not allow scanning of the room and limiting use to certain disciplines. D. Del George suggested encouraging faculty who are able to do alternate forms of assessments to do so. S. Hutchinson provided feedback that solely using the lockdown browser is not as useful, and there are certain benefits from online proctoring for students in STEM fields when seeking to transfer to a university. S. Hutchinson and V. Bonilla suggested the need for thorough training to assess whether there is a need to use Proctorio in certain courses and train faculty on how to properly use it
