Chapter 5 – Student Services

BP 5050 STUDENT SUCCESS AND SUPPORT PROGRAM

The District shall provide Student Success and Support Program services to students for the purpose of furthering equality of educational opportunity and academic success. The purpose of Student Success and Support Program services is to bring the student and the District into agreement regarding the student's educational goal through the District's established programs, policies, and requirements.

To help all students realize their educational goals, the College shall provide the student service resources necessary to enable them to develop individual educational plans. Those plans shall consist of, but not be limited to, the specific courses and the student services and special programs available, such as financial aid, to support the achievement of their goals.

The Superintendent/President shall establish administrative regulations to assure implementation of Student Success and Support Program services that comply with the Title 5 regulations.
