BP 5500 STANDARDS OF STUDENT CONDUCT

The Santa Monica Community College District has established regulations to encourage students to conduct themselves as responsible members of the college community and in a manner compatible with the educational missions of the District. Students are subject to District authority and the specific regulations established by the District. Those who violate the District regulations are subject to disciplinary actions, including but not limited to cancellation of registration, and may be denied future admission to the College.
