# RECOMMENDATION NO. 2 DISCONTINUANCE OF CERTAIN ACADEMIC PROGRAMS/SERVICES

As a result of the significant reductions in State funding proposed in the Governor's 2003-04 Budget for Community Colleges and the significant loss of revenue that the Santa Monica Community College District will thus experience, regrettably it is the opinion of the Santa Monica Community College Board of Trustees that the following academic services/programs be discontinued:

1.	Architecture	4.8 FTE
2.	Fashion Design and Merchandising	2.9 FTE
3.	Geographic Information Systems	.4 FTE
4.	Interior Design	5.4 FTE
5.	Office Information Systems	4.2 FTE
6.	Public Safety	3.9 FTE
7.	Recreation	.6 FTE
8.	Respiratory Therapy	2.1 FTE
9.	Tourism/Hospitality	.2 FTE
10.	Transportation Technology	8.4 FTE

It is the opinion of the Board of Trustees that it is in the best interests of the District that the appropriate number of academic employees be reduced. Therefore, it is the action of this Board of Trustees that due to the discontinuance of particular kinds of services/programs, the legal number of academic employees of a district, pursuant to Education Code Sections 87743 not be reemployed for the 2003-04 academic year.

It is further directed by the Board of Trustees that the Superintendent/President or her designee give issue a Notice of Recommendation Not to Re-employ in accordance with the provisions of Education Code Sections 87740 and 87743 to the number of academic employees allowable pursuant to Education Code Section 87743.

#### Comment:

Implementation of this recommendation will occur during a 60-day time period ending May 15, 2003. During this 60-day period, implementation will occur in continuous consultation with the Academic Senate, Budget Committee and Coordinating Council on all actions related to the Notice of Recommendation Not to Re-employ.
