The Santa Monica Community College District ("District" or "administration"), the Santa Monica College Faculty Association ("Faculty Association") and the California School Employees Association, Chapter 36 ("CSEA") hereby agree to creation of a joint College-wide Benefits Committee. The role of the committee is to contain the cost of the District's health benefits program while maintaining the quality of the benefits available to the employees, retirees, and eligible dependents. During the period of time prior to the committee submitting its recommendation(s), there shall be no negotiations between the parties on anything contained in Article 10 and the status quo as set out in Article 10 shall be maintained. Prior to commencing negotiations on anything contained in Article 10, the Benefits Committee shall be given an opportunity to make a recommendation on the subject matter. During the first week of the Fall or Spring semester, either party may request that the Benefits Committee make a recommendation on the subject matter. The Benefits Committee shall make a recommendation by the end of the semester following the semester in which the request is made. deadline may be extended by one semester by agreement of the co-chairs of the Benefits Committee; the co-chairs shall agree to such an extension when reasonably necessary to allow the Benefits Committee to complete its work. In the event that a recommendation is not received within the required time period, either party may request negotiations on the subject matter. Nothing in this article is intended to allow either party to be able to reopen this article.
