Description: Among first-time in college (FTIC) students, the average number of semester units successfully (C or better) completed during their first year.



Trend Across Years (1.14 Average Total Semester Units Successfully Completed in First Year)


Pathways, Redesign

The average number of units completed in the first year among FTIC has improved by over 3 units in the last six years, from 10.9 units among FTIC in 2014-2015 to 14.0 units among FTIC in 2019-2020. Students who complete an average of 15 units per semester are more likely to earn a 60+ unit associate degree and graduate within four years than students who complete fewer units. The College has not yet set a target

goal for improvement on this metric as this metric is new.




Disaggregated by Race/Ethnicity (1.14 Average Total Semester Units Successfully Completed in First Year)



On average, Asian FTIC students completed more units in their first year than any other racial/ethnic groups. When compared to Asian students, who completed an average of 17.5 units (2019-2020), Black students completed 7.3 fewer units in their first year. The College also produced an equity gap for Latine/x students; Latine/x students completed, on average, 12.0 units in the first year, 5.5 units fewer than Asian students in the same cohort year.

Equity gaps for Black and Latine/x students have slightly widened in 2019-2020 when compared to 2014-2015. However, both groups have improved on this metric over the last six years, and Black and Latine/x students completed more units in the most recently reported year than in previous years.
