

# Individual Faculty Racial Equity Analysis

Step-by-Step Instructions in Using the Racial Equity Analysis
Report in Precision Campus

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#### **Background**

The Office of Institutional Research developed a data tool in SMC Precision Campus to allow faculty to compile and analyze trend disaggregated course success data for the courses they teach. The tool is called **Instructor Report: Racial Equity Analysis.** The tool automatically filters data for only the sections taught by the person logged into the system (Precision Campus uses single sign-on using SMC login credentials).

The practice of disaggregating data by race/ethnicity is critical in informing our racial equity work. Disaggregated data is key to uncovering the inequities experienced by our racially minoritized students and provides insight on the salience of the inequity problem we are trying to address.

However, the act of data disaggregation alone is insufficient in advancing our racial equity goals. In their report, <u>Delivering the Promise of Progressive Policy: Strengthening the Academic Senate Professional Development in California's Community Colleges</u>, Hernandez-Hamad, Chase, and Bensimon (2021) assert:

"For disaggregated data to be an instrument of racial equity, practitioners must possess the skills to ask questions of the data that support sensemaking from a critical race perspective" (p. 11)

Therefore, we highly recommend reading <u>A Guide: Analyzing Individual Faculty Racial Equity</u> <u>Course Success Data</u> to support sensemaking of the disaggregated course outcomes data for your courses.

### **Step 1: Log into Precision Campus**

The website uses SMC single-sign on (SSO). Use your SMC email as your username and SMC network password (employees only) to access Precision Campus.



## **Step 2: Access the Report**

When logged in, you will see a menu of reports. Click on the *Program Review* menu.




The **Program Review** menu contains a list of reports. Find the one titled, **Instructor Report: Racial Equity Analysis**, under the **Course Outcomes** section.


#### Step 3: Familiarize Yourself with the Report

The bar on the far left is called the *Organizational Tree and Filter Bar* and contains a menu of options to customize your data.



Select and unselect the icons in the *Measures* to decide which metrics (success rate, number of successful grades, number of attempts) to include in the report.

The default displays all three metrics.





The filter bar includes several student and course attribute to filter or disaggregate your data further. The default setting disaggregates the data by student race/ethnicity, course, and academic year.

Click on the + sign next to the name of the attribute to disaggregate the data by the attribute.

Click on the values of the attribute (Asian, Black, Latinx, for example) to include the values or filter the values out of the report.



Move the *year range* slider to set the start and end years. By default, the data will display all data from 2015-2016 to 2020-2021. If you did not teach classes at SMC in the earlier years, your year range will start at the year you began teaching at SMC.


