

SANTA MONICA COLLEGE AB 540 INFO GUIDE



Assembly Bill 540 (AB 540) is a state law that makes it easier for nonresident students to afford going to a public college or university in California. It allows eligible students to pay in-state tuition and fees and is also a gateway to meeting eligibility for some types of financial aid.

Undocumented immigrants, U.S. citizens, and Lawful Permanent Residents may be eligible for AB 540 if they meet the requirements outlined below. Individuals with nonimmigrant visas (excluding T- and U-Visa), such as international students or visitors to the U.S., among others, are not eligible.

Noncredit coursework gives students the ability to build their skills in a free no risk environment and can help students establish AB540 status, based on the requirements listed below.

Requirements:

1. Time in California School

- 3 years of high school; or
- 3 years of high school coursework and a combination of 3 years in elementary, secondary, and/or high school; or
- 3 years of high school, adult school, and/or community college (noncredit or credit)
 - For noncredit courses at a community college and adult school, 420 hours of attendance is the equivalent to one year
 - For credit courses at a community college, 24 semester (or 36 quarter) completed credits is the equivalent to one year

2. Educational Level Achieved in California

- High school diploma or equivalent (e.g. GED, HiSET, TASC)
- Associate degree from a community college
- Having completed the minimum transfer requirements to a UC- or CSU-system university

• Hours are verified by attendance or class completion:

- $\circ\,$ Full class hours are verified for students who earn a P in a class.
- On-Ground & Scheduled Online Classes: For an incomplete class (SP, NP, W) hours are verified based on the student's hours of class attendance.
- *Flexible Online Classes:* For an incomplete class (SP, NP, W) hours are verified based on the student's first and last date of enrollment in the class.
- Repeated attempts of noncredit classes can be used towards hours.
- It is recommended that you keep track of your own hours.
