## 3 Options for Prioritizing Sabbaticals

# 15, 1st time recipients5 previous recipients

### 1st Time Priority:

- 1) 1st Time Sabbatical Recipients
  - Years of service therein
- 2) Sabbatical Recipients
  - Years of service
    - Doesn't matter how many sabbaticals one has had previously?
- 3) All approved sabbatical applications that were not awarded by the board of trustees will roll over to the next year as approved sabbaticals (reordering will happen again after the next year's sabbaticals are decided).

The choosing will go by year until the board approved sabbatical number has been reached. If the year has more sabbaticals than are left, a random drawing will occur of all the people of that year. I have given an example below.

A reality of this option: If the district continues with its minimum number of sabbatical enforcement, and by prioritizing first time sabbaticals, people who have previously received sabbaticals will possibly never receive another sabbatical in their SMC careers.

## **Years of Service Priority:**

- 1) Choose based on year of hire, return after unpaid leave, or last sabbatical—using the year they returned, whichever is more recent
  - Years of Service therein
- 2) All approved sabbatical applications that were not awarded by the board of trustees will roll over to the next year as approved sabbaticals (reordering will happen again after the next year's sabbaticals are decided).

The choosing will go by year until the sabbatical number has been reached. If the year has more sabbaticals than are left, a random drawing will occur of all the people of that year. I have given an example below.

## **Hybrid of First-time and Years of Service:**

- Everyone Starts with a base score of 5 for being eligible
- First time recipients will receive 1 extra bonus point.
- Then everyone gets 1 point per year of service beyond the initial eligibility year.

The choosing will go by point blocks until the sabbatical number has been reached. If the year has more sabbaticals than are left, a random drawing will occur of all the people of that year.

### 1st Time Priority:

According to New Recipient Priority, these first 3 years would be automatically awarded sabbaticals as these years don't go over the 8 awarded.
