Submission of External Official Transcripts and Test Scores

Students wishing to use course work from accredited institutions and or test scores:

- Are encouraged to meet with a counselor to discuss applicability toward a degree or certificate, as some coursework may not be needed.
- Must submit applicable official transcripts and test score reports from all relevant institutions/sources to the Admissions and Records Office by the published graduation deadlines in order to be eligible to receive the degree or certificate.
- Must have Official transcripts/test scores sent directly by the source institution (the college where the courses were taken) to Santa Monica College. Transcripts/test scores from students will not be accepted as unofficial, if submitted to courseling.
