Students are encouraged to meet with a counselor to discuss applicability of external credit (courses and test scores) toward a degree or certificate, as some coursework may not be accepted.

Submission of External Official Transcripts and Test Scores

Official transcripts and test score reports must be sent directly by the institution/agency to the office of Admissions and Records prior to the graduation deadlines to receive the degree and/or certificate.

Supporting Documents

Official documents must be maintained in the student's permanent record in the Admissions and Records Office. Such documentation includes (but is not limited to): official transcripts, test scores from College Board, International Baccalaureate Organization, military service separation papers, foreign transcript credit evaluations, etc.

AR 4111.5 Submission of Official Transcripts and Test Scores (old AR#)

Students who have completed coursework at other institutions and intend to pursue a SMC degree or certificate, and/or CSU GE or IGETC certification must submit test scores (ie: AP, CLEP, GCSE higher level exams, IB, etc.) and official transcripts of all applicable coursework.

All test scores and official transcripts must be sent directly from the awarding institution or agency to the SMC Admissions office.
