I. Call to Order/Approval of Agenda

V. Senate Operations & Brown Act

J. London emphasizes the importance of the Brown Act, including major requirements (public participation, limiting discussion to agendized items, etc.). Decisions should be made in public and people who those decisions affect should be included in the conversation.

Committee members discuss issues regarding Zoom—such as how to handle motions made in the chat. They also discuss the appropriateness of limiting time per speaker and/or the number of times each senator can speak. J. London, L. Hald, A. Nestler, and K. Chicas agree to meet to discuss these issues.



J. London reviews who is eligible to vote and how to indicate eligibility on Zoom. He notes that quorum consists of 31 out of 60 senators.

In the senate, resolutions are the main way that we can take action. J. London suggests committee members research the kinds of resolutions that other academic senates have made. Senators discuss whether resolutions must go through two reads in both the executive committee and senate.

VI. COVID 19 Update

H. Stahl notes that the senate can be more influential with student retention—for example, by sending targeted emails to students and posting about classes on social media.

S. Cordova informs that classes approved under emergency DE approval will soon likely no longer be able to be taught. The suspension of certain Brown Act rules is also set to come to an end in October.
