V. Action Items

a. Recommendations for Improving Understanding of Class Modalities 1st Read (J. Adams)

J. Adams notes that it's not always easy for students to understand when and how they need to be available when registering for a course. She also notes Title 5 regulations are changing regarding what constitutes substantive contact and what students need to be told when they sign up for a class. With these issues in mind, the Ad Hoc Modalities Committee recommends strengthening communication and shared governance. The online schedule of classes should be made clearer and more user-friendly, in consultation with faculty and students. Also, Academic Affairs should consult with the full senate, department chairs, and the Curriculum Committee, and it should strategically communicate basic principles and relevant information to instructors, counselors, students, and other key groups in the upcoming academic years.

b. DE Vision Recommendations 1st Read (J. Adams)

This document, which was produced by the Distance Education Committee, attempts to clarify and codify what SMC needs to do to have the best DE possible. Committee members discuss potential changes to DE-related professional development to make it more cohesive, to support faculty in learning new technology (rather than just telling them new technology is available), and to provide financial support for faculty training. Committee members also discuss ideas such as providing orientations for students, credentialling, and the need for ongoing funding for faculty who must frequently update their courses to keep them current.

c. AR 5110 Curriculum Committee: Structures, Functions, Responsibilities and Approval Process (S. Cordova)

AR 5110 asks us to review the structure of the Curriculum Committee every 3 years. Based on the workloads of representatives and conversations with department chairs, S. Cordova recommends decoupling Business/CSIS and Design Tech/Comm & Media Studies so that each department would have its own voting representative, rather than having to share representatives with enormous workloads. The curriculum specialist would also be listed as permanent non-voting member.
