Chapter 5 – Student Services

AR 5220 SHOWER FACILITIES FOR UNHOUSED STUDENTS

The district maintains shower facilities for student use on campus that may be used by any unhoused student who is enrolled in a non-credit course or enrolled in a minimum 0.5 credit course, has paid enrollment fees, and is in good standing with the district.

An unhoused student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.

Shower facilities and locker use are located on the main campus at the Core Performance Center (CPC), 2nd floor and are open to use by all students Monday through Friday (facility hours and limited locker use policy are posted at the facility and on the Kinesiology and Athletics Department website). The CPC is closed on weekends, holidays and when classes are not in session.
