# Credit Enrollment Continued Decline

### As of January 17, 2023

- ► Spring HEADCOUNT Down
  - 3.68% from last spring
- ► Spring CREDIT FTES Down
  - 6.47% from last spring
    - ► 2022-23 Annual decline currently -7.07%
- Spring NON-RESIDENT FTES slowly recovering
  - ► ↑ 6.19% from last spring
    - 2022-23 Annual increase currently+2.83%



## **Enrollment Challenges**

- More students opting out
  - Financial concerns / needing to prioritize work
  - Wanting to attend closer to home (higher cost of gas, lessen commute)
  - Dealing with post-pandemic anxiety / mental health challenges
  - Waiting for schools to "get back to normal"
- Students looking for employment opportunities
  - Clear path to a job
- Questioning of the value of higher education
  - Cycle of indebtedness
  - Eg. Tear the Paper Ceiling Project



## **Enrollment Challenges**

- International students
  - Lower yield / show-rate
    - Strength of dollar
    - Cost of living in the area
    - Trouble with visa appointments
    - Global inflation



## **Enrollment Opportunities**

- Redesigning the student experience
  - Coordinated communication
  - Cross-training of front-line staff (warm hand off)
  - Enrollment labs

- Working in high schools and middle schools
- Bringing students on campus

> High touch contact for students who stopped out and students in the pipeline to increase yield

- New students in high schools and during school trips to SMC
- Continuing students workshops online & in-person year-round
