Black Collegian Program will be moved to the counseling complex it starts right after 5:30 after the ICC meeting their will be a guest speaker.



This annual event happens once a year. Encourages club to attend the event as an official club. This can be a way to encourage incoming freshmen.


5.2 Al Gomez "Be The Match"






