8.1 Social Justice and Gender Equity Updates

- A.S. President appointed two students to the Presidential Task Force—Vice President, and Director of Student Advocacy. President expressed trust in Vice President and Dir. of Student Advocacy to participate in the meeting.
- Vice President and Dir. of Student Advocacy participated in an unofficial Gender Center meeting with some of the faculty. The professors wanted to know what the students want due to the possible controversial name of the center. Certain students are uncomfortable with having a "Women's Center" and Dir. of Student Advocacy is calling upon on the board to come up with ideas of a name and a way of involving students in the decision making process.
- Vice President mentioned having them vote online on Corsair for the name of the Center.
- President states that students should be involved since it's a student paid for Center. President encouraged students to participate in the process.
- Vice President stated that two professionals from other campuses spoke at the task force outlining the importance of the center.
- President also states that students should also know that it will be in the Cayton Center and therefore should be involved.
- Dir. of Student Advocacy said that it's a closed meeting and that we should put our suggestions towards Vice President and Dir. of Student Advocacy.
- The board agrees that a list of names being uploaded onto the Corsair seems like the best course of action
- Dr. Grass reiterated that it's also a Social justice Center for those that are marginalized; not just a gender center. Case workers, food pantry, and many other layers.
