

SMC Global Citizenship Committee Meeting Report

On 3rd October 2019, the Santa Monica College Global Citizenship Committee Meeting mainly involved two upcoming programs which are study abroad and global citizenship symposium.

At the beginning of the meeting, the Committee Chair mentioned we got 10,000 rewards from SMC for the spring study abroad project so that the Catalina Island program fee will be reduced to 500 dollars. On the other hand, the applications of Finland/Estonia is much less than the applications of Catalina Island and Costa Rica, so we need to do more propaganda on the Finland/Estonia program. There are some flyers that can propagate it in the Associated Students meeting. In addition, we discussed the future plan of study abroad in summer and winter vacations. The faculty member for summer vacation has not decided because there are few applications. We also discussed how to promote faculty members' enthusiasm. There are two main problems. Firstly, faculty members need to work for 24 hours to take care of all the students in 3 weeks which is a huge workload for them. Secondly, faculty members have families and children. Some committees say if they could take their family there, they will be more willing to come. However, if they go on the trip with their families, they might not take care of their jobs. Therefore, it still needs to be determined.

The second project is the Global Citizenship Symposium. The Chair claimed the reward of the winner. Furthermore, the main discussion of this part is about the categories of the works. Because it's hard to compare a film and a painting, and we need a winner in different categories. This year, the committee will determine the category of the works because the students always submit to the wrong category. Lastly, we decided to send flyers to different classes especially the classes related to global citizenship.
