#### VII. Discussion Items:

- **7.1** Drafting sustainability questions for funding proposal application (cont'd.)
  - Continuation of discussion from 10/18 Finance Committee meeting. Director of Budget Management David Duncan
    presented input provided by the sustainability office as well as sustainability guidelines developed by other campuses. He
    suggested that the committee focus primarily on food waste, especially those from large events.
  - The committee also discussed revising the Associated Students organization's current approach to funding food for events. Committee members expressed concerns about a lack of transparency on who is receiving food from Associated Students-funded events. The committee workshopped ideas to improve data collection for student events. The chair agreed to agendize an extended discussion of this issue for a future Finance Committee meeting and invite representatives from administration to give input and information.
  - The committee settled on proposing a tier system that imposes different zero waste requirements on events depending on the amount of money the event is spending on food. Members achieved a rough consensus to refer the proposed set of proposal revisions to the full A.S. board at a future board meeting.

- ICC Vice Chair Zach Makari provided a report on an unexpected expense incurred with Corsair Cafe during Club Row activities.
- President Cecilia Jeong provided a report on SMC mission statement imagining sessions and the appointment of a student to the District Planning Advisory Committee.
- Director of Budget Management David Duncan reported on the current status of the A.S. funding authorizations and reported on scheduling for future meetings.
- President Cecilia Jeong provided a report on Giving Thanksgiving and satellite campus outreach ad hoc committees.
- Director of Budget Management David Duncan provided an update on Cayton Center remodel ad hoc, which is creating a survey to gather feedback on Cayton Center remodel priorities.

- Counselor/Advisor Benny Blaydes provided a report on club row, which was a success with huge student turnout. He also discussed a recent HBCU fair and noted that scholarship applications are still available.
- Associate Dean Thomas Bui reminded the committee that there are only three finance meetings left in the semester. He encouraged directors to communicate this to students who may seek funding.
