## The UC System:

- Research and Theory Focused
- Full-time
- Large Class Size
- Application Fee: \$70



# Minimum UC Admission Requirements

- + 60 UC transferable semester units
  - + Check your SMC Unofficial Transcript
- + At least a 2.4 GPA, California Residents & AB 540
- + At least a 2.8 GPA, Non-California Residents/ International
- + 7 Course Pattern: Must be completed Spring before Fall transfer with a C or better
  - + 2 English- Eng 1 or 1D and Eng 2
  - + 1 Math- 2, 4, 7, 8, 10, 11, 13, 15, 21, 26, 28, 29, or 54
  - + 4 Courses- Chosen from at least 2 of the areas below:
    - + Arts and Humanities
    - + Social and Behavioral Sciences
    - + Physical and Biological Sciences

\*All courses must be UC transferable

# The Cost of the UC:

- + Tuition:
  - + \$14,436 per year (residents & AB 540)
  - + \$48,636 per year (non-residents/international)
- + Cost of Attendance
  - + \$40,000 to \$42,000 (residents & AB 540)
  - + \$74,000 to \$76,000 (non-residents/international)
- + UC can be affordable!
  - + Blue & Gold
    - + E.g. Family of 4 making \$80,000 /year or less can have tuition 100% covered
  - + Middle-Class Scholarships
    - + Families of 4 who make between \$80,000-\$217,000/year

## What about the Blue and Gold plan?

UC's Blue and Gold Opportunity Plan ensures that, at a minimum, systemwide tuition and fees are covered for eligible students with parent total incomes of \$80,000 or less.

  - + While you can't minor at this level, you can explore possibilities through electives.

# IGETC

## (General Education Pattern)

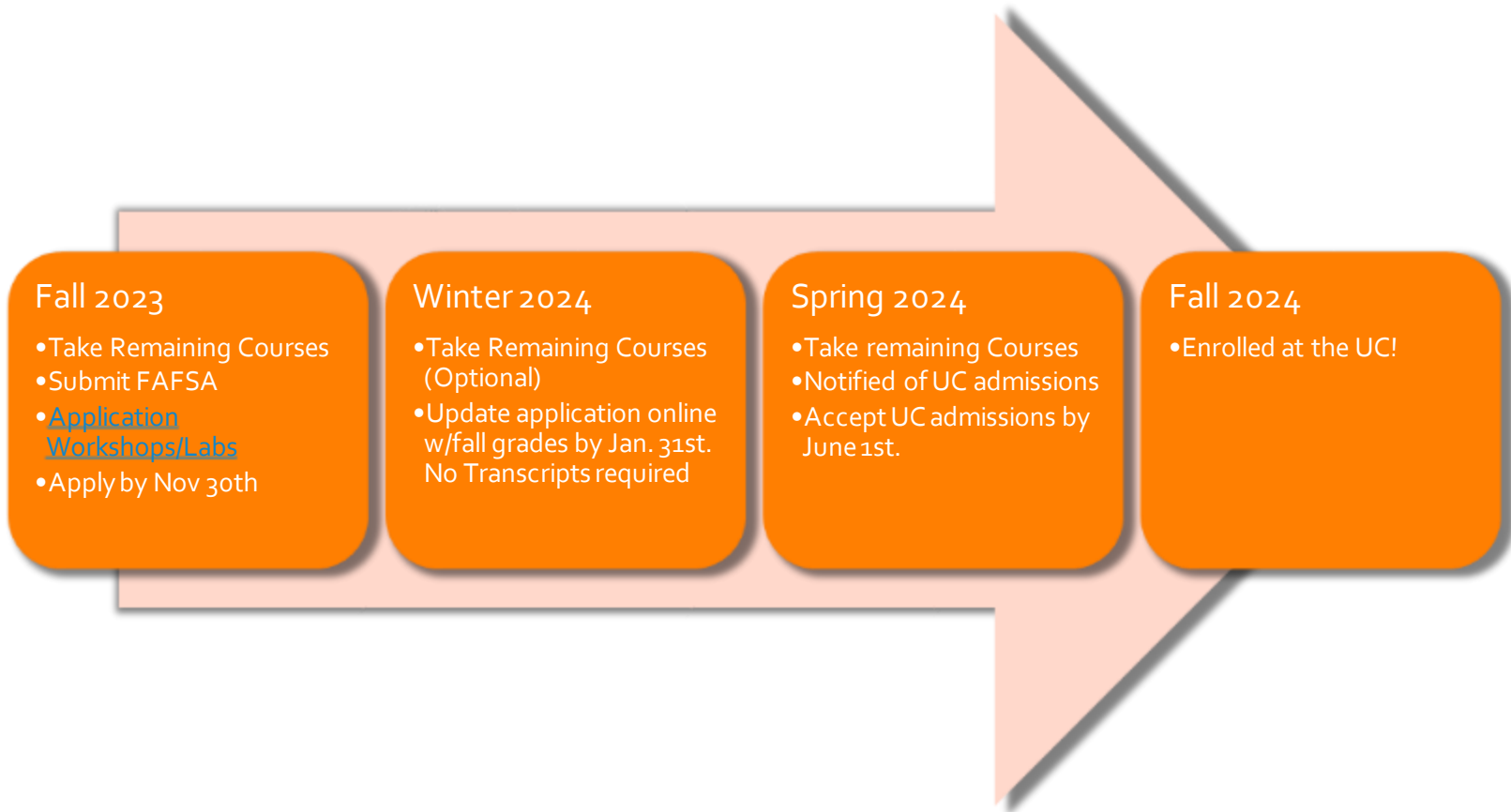
- Must have “C” or better
- Recommend completion prior to transfer.
- Equivalency of course work from other schools **must be approved by a counselor**
- Foreign course work cannot be used
- Student must apply for certification

# Application Filing Periods

- + Fall application opens August 1st
- + Application submission begins October 1st
- + Application deadline is November 30th
  
- + Winter and Spring Applications Vary
- + Not all campuses open for Winter and Spring Admissions

# Application/Admission Timeline

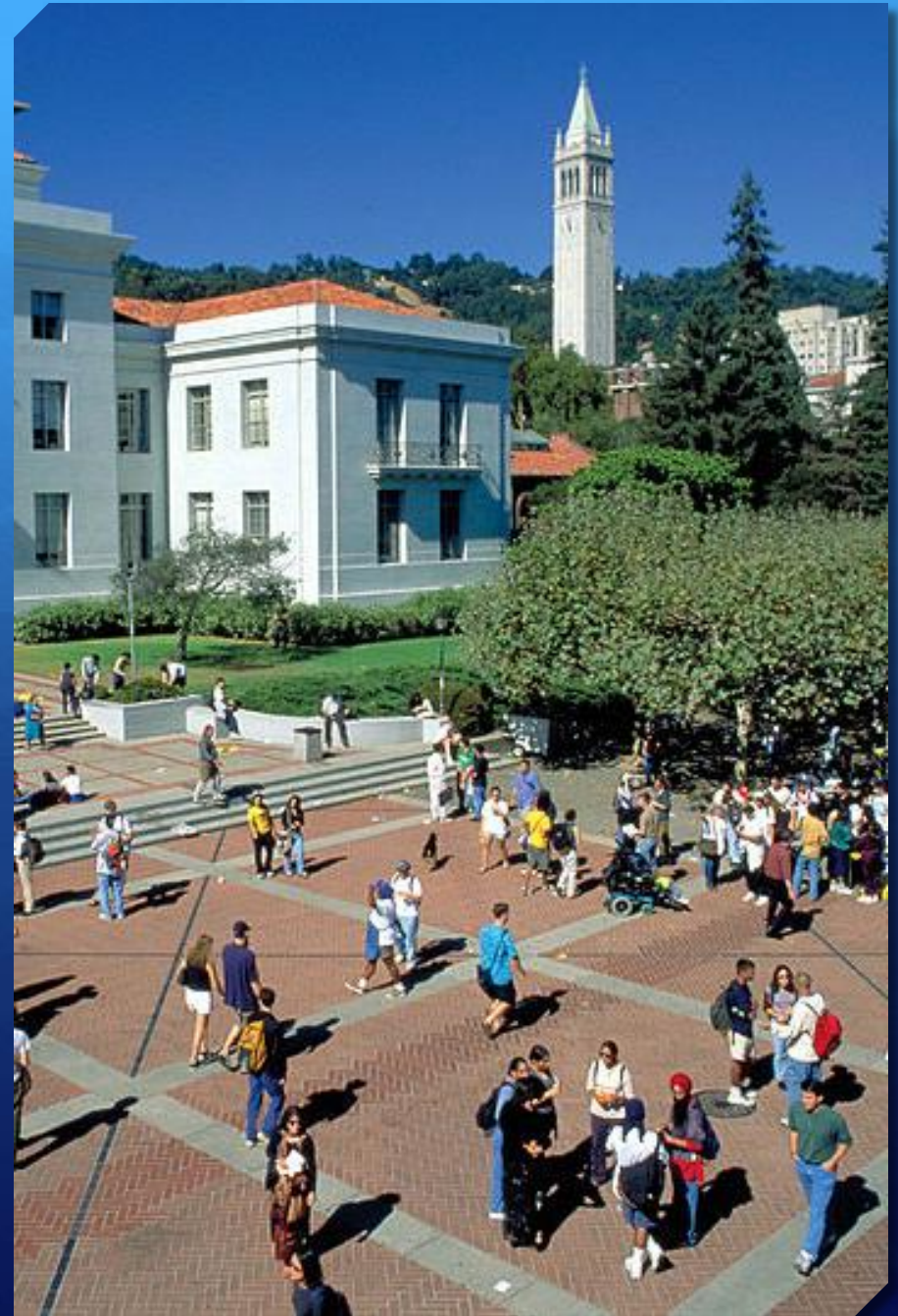


\*By the end of spring student will meet min. UC admission requirements, as much major preparation as possible, completed IGETC certification petition, and sent official transcripts to the UC.



## UC Berkeley

- Intense academic climate

# UC Davis



- Originally known as the University of California Farm, it still has a more rural feel than other campuses
- Highest graduation rate in the UC System
- Strong academic advising system
- Recognized for one of the best internship programs in the country
- 2 years of guaranteed student housing





## UC Davis

- Davis is a true “college town” – students comprise half of the population of 50,000 residents
- Bicycles are the primary mode of transportation: there are 46 miles of bike paths on & around the campus
- Just over an hour to San Francisco

# Final Transfer Tips...

- All U.S. and foreign college and university course work **must be reported** on the admissions application
- Complete minimum admissions requirements especially in English and math, as soon as possible.
- Aim to complete sequences at one campus:
  - (e.g.: Physics 21,22,23) prior to transfer
- Apply to several campuses!
  - Give yourself options!
